
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS TOOL FOR INSERT





PREPARATION

IMPORTANT NOTE.

The insert installation tool is intended to drive a brass insert into a pre-drilled 3/4" thick compact laminate (CGL) and solid reinforced composite (SCRC) materials.

TOOLS NEEDED.

CAUTION: Be sure to use proper safety gear.

1. #1080-130 Insert Installation Tool




2. Brass Insert




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

A. Place the component on a flat surface with drilled pilot holes facing up. Fig. 1




- B. Locate the brass insert and the #1080-130 insert installation tool.
- C. Fasten brass insert into insert installation tool until it is fully seated. Fig. $\bf 2$



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- D. Using a power driver at a low setting, center the brass insert straight into pilot hole and drive insert until fully inserted. Do not over-torque. **Fig. 3**
- E. Set driver in reverse setting to remove insert tool. Fig. 4



F. Ensure insert sits fully flush with material surface. If insert is not fully flush with material surface, increase driver torque and drive insert until it is completely flush with surface of material.



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
