

# Mind the Gap

Restroom needs are changing. With the trend toward gender-neutral restrooms, privacy is important. Social media sites are buzzing with complaints about that embarrassing gap between doors and panels in many toilet partition systems.

The problem stems primarily from partitions that are prefabricated instead of made-to-order. Gaps result when the restroom space is larger than the minimum recommended dimensions for the premade-size stiles and doors.

Commonly seen concerns include:

- Standard 12" floor clearances on partition doors.
- Gaps between doors and stiles found on typical toilet partitions.
- Door latch bolts that do not lock all the way causing doors to open unintentionally.
